

## Privacy

Information according to art.13 of Legislative Decree No. 196 of June 30, 2003 containing details on the Code relating to the protection of personal data.

According to art. 13 of the aforementioned legislative decree containing regulations relating to the protection of personal data, data willingly supplied for the activation of the required services will be handled by Consorzio Sestante who will adopt appropriate measures to guarantee their safety and privacy through the observance of the above mentioned regulations.

### 1. Information collection

The present information concerns the data (e-mail addresses and also personal data) collected by the [www.consorziostante.eu](http://www.consorziostante.eu) web site and following registrations to their mailing list.

The cancellation of data, their transformation into an anonymous format and the blocking of data where laws are violated regarding the website [www.consorziostante.eu](http://www.consorziostante.eu) and subsequent links indicated in mail-outs by Consorzio Sestante will be permitted at all times

### 2. Data handling purposes and methods

The collected data are handled exclusively for the following purposes:

- a) to establish relationships with users to satisfy information requests
- b) to send communications concerning new initiatives
- c) to carry out statistical analyses
- d) to comply with obligations stated by law
- e) to send newsletters

### 3. The type of data supply

### 4. Data communication and diffusion

Personal data collected will not be diffused or communicated to a third-party unless foreseen by the nature of the agreement and/or as stated by the law and in any case according to the methodology permitted by them.

Consorzio Sestante shares profiles and names with its partners and sponsors. This does not apply to any personal information which could identify any individual person.

Consorzio Sestante is not responsible for any violation of privacy committed by these sites. The regulations concerning the handling of personal data regard the information collected directly by Consorzio Sestante

### 5. Rights of the Party concerned

Correction/updating of personal data. Art.7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 gives the party concerned the use of specific rights. In particular:

The party concerned has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or not of personal data – even when registration has not yet occurred - concerning him/her as well as their communication in an intelligible way.

The party concerned has the right to obtain indication of:

- a). the origin of the personal data;
- b). data handling purposes and methods;
- c). the logic applied in case of handling by electronic devices;
- d). the identification and essential data relating to the owner, the people in charge and of the appointed representative according to article 5, paragraph 2;
- e). persons or person categories to whom personal data could be communicated or who could become acquainted with them as appointed representatives in the state territory, those in charge or appointed.

The party concerned has the right to obtain:

- a) data updating, correction or, in case of his/her interest, data integration;
- b) the cancellation of data, their transformation into an anonymous format and the blocking of data where laws are violated, including data whose conservation is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected and later handled;
- c) the demonstration that those to whom the data have been communicated or diffused have been acquainted with the operations under the letters a) and b) – as far as their content is concerned – except when such a fulfilment reveals to be impossible or involves the use of means clearly out of proportion with respect to the rights protected.

The party concerned has fully or in part the right to object to:

- a) the handling of personal data concerning him/her for legitimate reasons though relevant to the collection aim;
- b) the handling of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising materials, materials of a direct sell nature, or for completion of market research or for commercial communications.

## 6. Responsibility for data-handling
